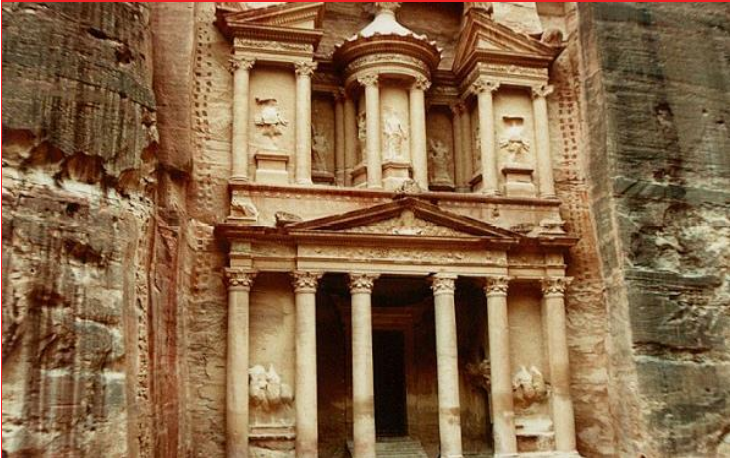

Itinerary

Day 1 Feb 14: WINNIPEG – TEL AVIV

14Feb Air Canada 260 Winnipeg-Toronto 0645/1013

14Feb Air Canada 084 Toronto-Tel Aviv 1650/1015 15Feb

Day 2 Feb 15: ARRIVE TEL AVIV (D)

Arrival at Ben-Gurion International Airport. Meeting and assistance by SMILE airport representative. Transfer from airport to your hotel for check in, Dinner at the hotel.

Hotel: Tal Hotel, Tel Aviv

Day 3 Feb 16: TEL AVIV (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Tour Jaffa, Walk along the Rothschild Boulevard. End the day at Saron Market, the largest indoor culinary market that operates 7 days a week.

Hotel: Tal Hotel, Tel Aviv

Day 4 Feb 17: TEL AVIV (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit Tel Aviv Museum of Modern Art, followed by Tel Aviv Port. Free time at leisure in the afternoon.

Hotel: Tal Hotel, Tel Aviv

Day 5 Feb 18: TEL AVIV - HAIFA (B,D)

After breakfast, meet the guide who will accompany you for the rest of the duration of touring in Israel. Visit Caesarea ancient Roman seaport, Druze Village, Akko ancient city. Continue north to Haifa.

Hotel: Bay Club Hotel, Haifa

Day 6 Feb 19: HAIFA - TIBERIAS (B)

After breakfast, depart for Nazareth, pass Cana, visit Galilee, Capernaum, Mount of Beatitudes and Tabgha.

Hotel: Golan Hotel, Tiberias

Day 7 Feb 20: TIBERIAS - JERUSALEM (B)

After breakfast, depart the Galilee and travel along the Jordan Rift Valley to the remains of Beit She'an, one of the oldest settled sites in the country. Next stop is Beit Alpha. Continue southwards along Jordan River, view Jericho. Ascend the Judean Hills to Jerusalem.

Hotel: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 8 Feb 21: JERUSALEM (B)

Visit the Israel Museum and Shrine of the Book Museum. Followed by Machane Yehudah Shuk Market where Shook and Cook offers tasting and shopping tour in the market, combined with Israeli food cooking workshop. Suitable for vegans (this meal is optional)

Hotel: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 9 Feb 22: JERUSALEM (B,D)

After breakfast, visit the Old City of Jerusalem. Time out for

dinner at a restaurant.

Hotel: Prima Kings Hotel, Jerusalem

Day 10 Feb 23: JERUSALEM - RAMON (B,L)

After hotel check out, head towards Masada, a UNESCO site. Continue along the Dead Sea. Have lunch. Proceed drive through the Negev desert to arrive at the Ramon Crater.

Hotel: Isrotel Ramon Inn, Mitzpe Ramon

Day 11 Feb 24: RAMON – WADI RUM (B,D)

Wake up to view the Ramon Crater. After breakfast, drive via the crater heading south to Nature Reserve of Timna. Tour the town of Eilat. Proceed to Arava border to cross into Jordan, where your Jordanian guide and vehicle will await you. Dinner and overnight

Accommodation tenting at Wadi Rum – Captain Camp

Day 12 Feb 25: WADI RUM - PETRA (B,L,D)

Tour of Petra. Lunch at a local restaurant

Hotel: Petra Old Village Hotel

Day 13 Feb 26: PETRA- AMMAN (B,D)

After breakfast, depart Petra and drive north to Madaba – the “mosaic city of the Middle East”. Continue to Mt. Nebo. Arrive at Amman. Lunch. And followed by panoramic Amman city tour.

Hotel: Geneva Hotel, Amman

Day 14 Feb 27: AMMAN - JERUSALEM (B)

After breakfast, leave Amman and arrive at Allenby Crossing with Israel. You will be assisted with passport control and border crossing procedures. At the crossing, you will be met and transfer to Jerusalem.

Day 15 Feb 28: DEPART JERUSALEM (B)

After breakfast you will be transferred to Ben Gurion International Airport for your flight home.
