Day 1 Arrival at Tashkent.

Explore the National Art-Gallery Happy Bird, gaining insight into Uzbekistan's contemporary art scene. Explore the Shahi-Zinda mausoleum architectural complex.

Day 5 Samarkand - Exploring Ancient Samarkand and Local Craftsmanship.

Delve into Samarkand's scientific heritage with a visit to Ulukbek's Observatory. Discover the history and grandeur of Tamerlane at the Amir Timur Mausoleum. Explore the diverse religious landscape of Samarkand with visits to the Roman Catholic St. John the Baptist Church, the Church of Intercession Blessed Virgin, and the Orthodox Cathedral of St. Alexis of Moscow. Conclude your journey by paying your respects at the Mausoleum of the Prophet Saint Daniel. Visit to the Eternal City, a unique tourist complex that offers cultural and historical insights.

Day 6 Samarkand - Artistry and Wine Culture

Immerse yourself in the local arts and crafts at Konigil village and the Meros Paper Mill. Delight in a hands-on workshop showcasing the ancient techniques of crafting handmade paper. Partake in a pottery workshop that offers unique, ancient crafting techniques and remarkable designs.

Explore the art of silk carpet production at the Samarkand Bukhara Silk Carpets Production workshop. Experience the rich historical heritage at the National (historical) Costume Theatre El Merosi. Enjoy a visit to the Khovrenko Wine Cellar.

Day 7 Shahrisabz - Exploring UNESCO Treasures

Shahrisabz, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its historical significance and architectural wonders. En route, stop by the Urgut ancient local market, famous for its unique suzannes (embroidered textiles). Embark on a scenic journey through the Karategin ridge, visit the enigmatic Devil's Plateau. In Shahrisabz and begin your exploration at the Chor-Chonor garden and mosque. Explore the "White Palace" (Ak-Saray), the Kok Gumbaz Mosque, visit the Gumbazi Seidan mausoleum and Khazrati Imam Mosque.

Day 8 Bukhara - Unveiling Bukhara's Past. Exploring UNESCO Treasures

Begin your journey in Bukhara with a visit to the imposing Ark Fortress, explore the unique Chor Minor and Bolo Hauz Mosque. Experience a workshop on traditional Uzbek cuisine and discover the art of preparing Uzbek plov. Admire the grandeur of the Kalon Minaret and Mosque. Immerse yourself in the atmosphere of the Taki Zargaron Trading Dome. Visit to the Ulugbek Madrasa, a center of learning and spirituality. Pay your respects at the Ismail Samani Mausoleum.

Day 9 Bukhara - Architectural Marvels and Cultural Gems

Pay your respects at the Ismail Samani Mausoleum. Explore the exquisite Samanids Mausoleum, an ancient gem of Islamic architecture. Admire the intricate details of the Nodir Divan Begi Madrasa, showcasing the city's artistic heritage. Discover the grandeur of the Poi-Kalyan Complex, featuring the Kalyan Minaret and Mosque. Explore the Bahauddin Architectural Complex.

Day 10 Bukhara - Architectural Marvels and Cultural Gems
